Meeting began at 6pm

Mike Armato made a presentation of his wayfinding sign samples. The overall material is black aluminum with gold accents similar in style to what we currently have on the black poles in the downtown area. The main difference was the size of the signs being 6" by 32" and having reflective lettering of a standardized height that can be easily seen while driving.

Mike also provided a quote for 30 of the signs with the necessary accessories for installation.
Total cost for signs: \$6,639.00

Mike recommended the following:

- Public Parking lots
- Parks
- Schools not located on State Street
- Funeral Home
- Fire Department
- Post Office
- Churches

Once final board approval is received, Mike said the signs could be completed within a 3 week time period.

The committee plans to perform an inventory for the downtown area to indicate where the signs should be placed and the types of destinations that should be listed on the signs.

The committee approved of the design and recommended forwarding on to the BDC for approval.

The committee will meet again within 2 weeks to review the inventory and also review 1 or 2 new façade applications.
