Step 3

Define multiple strategies underneath each goal for achieving them

Step 4

Define Objectives for each strategy

Step 5

Identify key stakeholders in the community that will be effected as well as contribute

to the mission

Step 6

Identify key metrics that the village can track to assess progress towards the goal

Step 7

Set a schedule for achieving those goals

Step 8

Build a plan working backwards from the schedule specifying certain tactics with

timelines

Step 9

Use Metrics to measure progress and modify the plan as we move forward
