In accordance with PA 97-609 and certain requirements within this act, the Village of Hampshire is required to post payments by the employer to the employee for salary, health insurance, housing allowance, vehicle allowance, clothing/uniform allowance, bonuses, loans, vacation, personal and sick days granted or PTO days granted. Salary and benefit information for employees are for salaries for Fiscal Year 2019 as it represents numbers that are projected to be earned at the completion of the fiscal year. Numbers do not become actual until the completion of the fiscal year.
