Business Development Commission Meeting Minutes 234 S. State St, Hampshire, IL 60140 (Virtual Meeting Optional)

- 4. Discussion of a Zoning Amendment to Allow Projecting Signs in the Village (moved up in the agenda from bullet 6)
 - Assistant to the Village Manager Wray presented and sought input regarding ordinance updates to business signage that projects off the front of a building.

The current community graphics regulations do not allow any wall sign to project more than 12" from the wall. The Planning and Zoning Commission asked for the BDC's input before holding and hearings or votes on a potential amendment to allow such signs.

• The BDC unanimously agreed that it is open to adjusting the current ordinance to encourage more signage of this type.

5. Update of the Downtown Streetscape Project

• Village Administrator Hedges discussed the nearing completion of the overall project, with minor updates to be finished in the near future. There will be a ribbon cutting ceremony on August 28th, prior to the Coon Creek Days parade.

6. Beautification Committee Report

- Commissioner Swalwell presented the following Façade Program updates:
 - o 123 Washington Ave. The Village Board approved 75% reimbursement of the enhancements outlined in the façade application.
 - o 124 S. State St. façade update is progressing and should be completed in the coming months.

7. Developing a long-term strategy for the Business Development Commission

- Commissioner Krajecki recapped the work that the BDC has completed throughout the year regarding the long-term strategy as it relates to business development for the Village.
- The BDC reviewed and discussed the future business strategy as it applies to land use and communication approaches. Topics included attracting/retaining businesses, diversifying the local economy, enhance the community's image and provide additional resources to prospective businesses as it relates to both.
