The regular meeting of the Business Development Commission of Hampshire was called to order by Commissioner Krajecki in person and through a MS Teams video chat on September 14th, 2022.

1. Call to order at 6:32 pm

- 3. Meeting Minutes Approval From 8/10/22:

- 4. Update of the Downtown Streetscape Project
  - Assistant to the Village Manager Josh Wray discussed that the native landscaping was recently installed and will sustain our environment. In addition, new LEDs have been received to update the historic clock. The last remaining element, the new streetlights, are on order.

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- 5. Beautification Committee Report
  - Commissioner Swalwell presented the following Façade Program updates:
    - Blocks Painting is done, the rest of the update is in progress
    - Rose Garden Approved façade and the owner is in progress of retaining a contractor. There is question as to when the project will begin due to the contractor's availability.
    - The Kave façade update is in progress
    - Hampshire Social Exterior works is near complete. Interior work is in progress and their anticipated grand opening is expected near Christmas

  - Commissioner Krajecki recapped the work that the BDC has completed throughout the year regarding the long-term strategy as it relates to business development for the Village.
  - The BDC reviewed and discussed the future business strategy as it applies to Village Approval and Infrastructure approaches. Topics included attracting/retaining businesses, diversifying the local economy, enhance the community's image and provide additional resources to prospective businesses as it relates to both.
  - Next steps would be to identify the top strategies to focus on.
