ABATING SPECIAL TAXES LEVIED FOR THE 2016 TAX YEAR (COLLECTABLE IN 2017) TO PAY DEBT SERVICE ON THE SPECIAL SERVICE AREA BONDS ISSUED FOR SPECIAL SERVICE AREA #19 IN THE VILLAGE OF HAMPSHIRE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village has previously issued certain Special Service Area Special Tax Bonds, Series 2007A and 2007B, for its Special Service Area No. 19, pursuant to its Ordinance No. 07-41 enacted June 21, 2007; and

WHEREAS, said bonds were issued in the amount of \$25,215,000 and were labeled Special Service Area Number 19 ("SSA 19"), Special Tax Bonds, Series 2007A and Series 2007B (Crown Development Projects - Prairie Ridge East); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tender Offer approved by the Village by its Resolution No. 10-10, enacted August 5, 2010, certain of said bonds have been purchased and cancelled as of September 3, 2010; and

WHEREAS, by its Ordinance No. 07-41, identified above, the Village levied certain special taxes against the properties located in the respective Special Service Areas, in order to pay principal and interest coming due on said bonds; and

WHEREAS, a large portion of said bonds having been purchased and cancelled, there is no longer a need to provide for future payments of principal or interest thereon in the amounts originally estimated and levied for; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the special taxes previously levied may be abated as set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES, OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMPSHIRE, KANE COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The taxes previously levied in Ordinance No. 07-41 for the 2016 Tax Year (to be collected in 2017) shall be and hereby are abated in an amount equal to \$2,114,203.40.

Section 2. The County Clerk shall be and is hereby directed to abate from the amount originally levied for special taxes for Special Service Area No. 19, for 2016 (collectable in 2017), to wit: \$2,139,234.00 as set forth in Village Ordinance No. 07-41, an amount equal to \$2,114,203.40, leaving a balance of special taxes to be levied equal to \$25,030.60.

Section 3. The Village Clerk shall promptly upon its adoption file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the County Clerk of Kane County, Illinois.

Section 4. Any motion, order, resolution or ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance is to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded and waived.

Section 5. If any section, subdivision, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be void, invalid, or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take full force and effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.

AN ORDINANCE

ABATING TAXES LEVIED FOR THE 2016 TAX YEAR (COLLECTABLE IN 2017) TO PAY DEBT SERVICE ON THE ISSUANCE OF UP TO \$2,750,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION REFUNDING BONDS (ALTERNATE REVENUE SOURCE), SERIES 2012 FOR THE VILLAGE OF HAMPSHIRE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village previously has issued certain refunding bonds, referred to as up to \$2,750,000 General Obligation Refunding Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source) Series 2012, by its Ordinance No. 12-25 enacted on December 6, 2012; and

WHEREAS, said refunding bonds refunded all or a portion of the prior bond issue referred to as the General Obligation Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source), Series 2006A; the prior bond issue referred to as the General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2003; and certain Debt Certificates, Series 2003; and

WHEREAS, said bonds are by the terms of Ordinance No. 12-25 to be payable from certain monies, to wit: all municipal utility taxes on electricity and gas imposed pursuant to Division 11 of Article 8 of the Municipal Code (the "Pledged Revenues"), and, in the alternative, if necessary, from ad valorem taxes levied against taxable property within the Village; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 12-25 included in its terms a levy of taxes for payment of principal and interest coming due during the period from May 1, 2016 to April 30, 2017 ("Fiscal Year 2017"); and

WHEREAS, the Village has accumulated or will have accumulated sufficient Pledged Revenues, as defined in Ordinance No. 12-25, for the purpose of paying debt service on the General Obligation Refunding Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source), Series 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Village is authorized to abate certain taxes when it is determined that sufficient funds are available from any other source which lawfully may be applied to payment of its obligations.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMPSHIRE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Corporate Authorities of the Village of Hampshire adopt the recitals set forth above, and hereby direct the application of the Pledged Revenues in an amount sufficient to pay the principal and interest due to be paid during Fiscal Year 2017 arising out of the up to \$2,750,000 General Obligation Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source) – Series 2012 previously issued.

Section 2. The County Clerk is hereby directed to abate in its entirety the tax levy for the 2016 tax year (taxes collectable in 2017) for the up to \$2,750,000 General Obligation Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source), Series 2012, as set out in Village of Hampshire Bond Ordinance No. 12-25 previously filed with the County Clerk.

Section 3. Forthwith upon the adoption of this Ordinance, the Village Clerk shall file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the County Clerk of Kane County, Illinois.

Section 4. Any motion, order, resolution, or ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance is to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded and waived.

Section 5. If any section, subdivision, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be void, invalid, or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village, by Ordinance No. 15-09, adopted on the 19th day of March, 2015 provided for the future issuance of not to exceed \$1,600,000.00 General Obligation Refunding Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source), Series 2015, for the purpose of refinancing and refunding the bonds previously issued as Village of Hampshire General Obligation Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source), Series 2009A; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authorization of Ordinance No. 15-09, the Corporate Authorities of the Village thereafter approved issuance of certain bonds, designated as \$1,175,000 General Obligation Refunding Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source), Series 2016 Bonds [sic], by motion and vote at the regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees held on March 3, 2016, for the purpose of partially refinancing and refunding certain bonds previously issued and known as the Village of Hampshire General Obligation Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source) Series 2009A; and further, said Ordinance provided for the levy of a direct annual tax sufficient to pay principal and interest and other proper expense on said Bonds in the event that the alternate sources of funding otherwise provided for the payment of debt service on said Series 2016 Bonds were not available or sufficient to pay the outstanding debt service for any given fiscal year; and

- (i) all collections distributed to the Village from municipal utility taxes on electricity and gas imposed pursuant to Division 11 of Article 8 of the Illinois Municipal Code, as supplemented and amended from time to time, or substitute taxes therefor as provided in the future, and/or
- (ii) revenues or funds to be deposited by the Village in a special tax allocation fund created or designated pursuant to the Tax Increment Allocation Redevelopment Act of the State of Illinois, as supplemented and amended from

time to time (the "Pledged Revenues"), and,

(iii) in the alternative, if necessary, from ad valorem taxes levied against taxable property within the Village; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 15-09, authorizing the issuance of the bonds and filed with the County Clerk, provided for the levy of ad valorem real estate taxes in certain amounts to cover payments of principal and interest due on the bonds, including a levy of taxes sufficient to pay the principal and interest coming due during the period from May 1, 2016 to April 30, 2017 ("Fiscal Year 2017"); and

WHEREAS, the Village has accumulated or will have accumulated sufficient Pledged Revenues, as defined in Ordinance No. 15-09 for the purpose of paying debt service on the General Obligation Refunding Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source), Series 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Village is authorized to abate certain taxes when it is determined that sufficient funds are available from any other source which lawfully may be applied to payment of its obligations.

RE: Disposal of International TerraStar Truck by Sale

Background. The FY17 operating budget included the acquisition of two trucks to aid operations in the Street Division. The first truck, a large plow and dump truck, was approved at the May 5, 2016 board meeting. The second truck was a Ford F-550, was approved at the October 6, 2016 board meeting. The Ford F-550 will replace the International TerraStar that is currently in the Village fleet.

Analysis. At the time the Ford truck purchase was authorized, the disposal method for the TerraStar was left to be determined at a later date. Bonnell Industries offered to accept the TerraStar as a trade for the Ford truck for \$30,000, however, the Village has successfully negotiated the sale of the truck for \$35,000. It is in the best interest of the Village to accept the private party offer to purchase the truck at \$35,000 rather than the trade for \$30,000.00.

Recommendation. Staff recommends adoption of the attached ordinance authorizing the sale of the TerraStar upon receipt of the sum of \$35,000 and the delivery of the Ford F-550.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL PERSONAL PROPERTY (2012 INTERNATIONAL TERRASTAR AND SNOW REMOVAL AND ICE CONTROL EQUIPMENT)

WHEREAS, the Village of Hampshire is the owner of a certain motor vehicle, that being a 2012 International Terrastar truck including snow removal and ice control equipment which has in the past been utilized for Public Works Department Street Division purposes; and

WHEREAS, said truck is no longer needed for the intended purpose and the Public Works Department, Street Division or Village has no other need for the motor vehicle and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Hampshire have therefore determined that the motor vehicle is not necessary or useful to the Village and that the best interests of the Village would be served by the sale and conveyance of said vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Village is authorized under the Illinois Municipal Code, Section 11-76-4, to authorize the sale of personal property in such manner as the corporate authorities may designate, with or without advertising the sale; and

WHEREARE, the Village will sell said vehicle and equipment to a private party for the amount of \$35,000.00 (Thirty-five thousand and no/100 dollars).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMPSHIRE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Corporate Authorities determine and find that the following described personal property, to wit: International TerraStar Truck, VIN: # 1HTJSSKK9CJ406336, now owned by the Village, is no longer necessary or useful to the Village and the best interests of the Village will be served by its sale.
- Section 2. The Village shall be and hereby is authorized and directed to transfer and sell said personal property to a private party; and, the Village President and Village Clerk shall be and hereby are authorized to execute and deliver to the Buyer an appropriate Motor Vehicle title and/or Bill of Sale, upon receipt of said sum, \$35,000.00 (Thirty-five thousand and no/100 dollars).
- Section 3. Any and all ordinances, resolutions, and orders, or parts thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of any such conflict, are hereby superseded and waived.

AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE, CHAPTER TWO: POLICE REGULATIONS, ARTICLE VI: PARKING REGULATIONS, BY ADDING CERTAIN PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON WHITE OAK STREET AND JEFFERSON AVENUE, AND MODIFYING CERTAIN PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON EDGEWOOD AVENUE AND HIGH AVENUE IN THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the Village has authority to establish rules and regulations governing parking of vehicles in the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village formerly adopted certain restrictions for parking on Edgewood Drive and on High Avenue at the time that Hampshire High School was located on State Street in the Village; and

WHEREAS, the high school has been relocated by CUSD 300, and the Corporate Authorities deem it necessary and advisable to modify the restrictions for parking on Edgewood Drive and High Avenue at this time; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have identified issues concerning parking of vehicles on Jefferson Avenue in the vicinity of Seyller Park in the Village, and on White Oak Street extending easterly and southerly from Stoneshire Court in the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities deem it necessary and advisable to add certain restrictions for parking on Jefferson Avenue between Madison Street and Stoneshire Court, and on White Oak Street easterly and southerly from Stoneshire Court at this time.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMPSHIRE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Hampshire Municipal Code of 1985, as previously amended, shall be and hereby is further amended to establish a new "No Parking" place as follows:

CHAPTER 2 POLICE REGULATIONS

ARTICLE VI PARKING REGULATIONS

SECTION 2-6-1 NO PARKING PLACES

It shall be unlawful for any person at any time to stop, stand or park any vehicle at any of the following locations, except when necessary to avoid

conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the direction of a police officer or traffic control device:

* * *

Q. On Edgewood Avenue on the south side of the street.

...on both sides of the street; provided, however, that during the hours between nine o'clock (9:00) A.M. and one o'clock (1:00) P.M., on Monday through Friday each week; residents of properties located on Edgewood Avenue between State Street and Prairie Street may park vehicles owned by them on the north side of said street, provided that any such vehicle parked on said street must display a resident parking permit obtained from the village clerk; and any vehicle not displaying such permit shall be subject to citation for improper parking.

R. On High Avenue on the south side of the street.

...on both sides of the street, between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) A.M. and one o'clock (1:00) P.M., Monday through Friday; except that residents of properties located on High Avenue may park vehicles owned by them on said street during said time period, provided that any such vehicle parked on said street must display a resident parking permit obtained from the village clerk; and any vehicle not displaying such permit shall be subject to citation for improper parking. (Ord. 04 36, 8 19 2004)

- BB. On Jefferson Street, on the north side only, from Madison Street extending east to Stoneshire Court.
- CC. On White Oak Street, on the northerly and easterly side of the street from the location of the driveway serving the property at 207 White Oak Street extending easterly and southerly to the location of the north side of the driveway for the property at 219 White Oak Street.
- DD. On White Oak Street, on the southerly and westerly side of the street from the location of the easternmost access to the parking lot for the Park District property lot extending southerly to the location of the driveway for the property at 216 White Oak Street.

Section 3. All ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded and waived.
