

Sewer Deduct Meter Program

Depending on how much water your household uses outside, non-sewered water may be a significant cost to your family. Non-sewered water is water that comes from the Village's municipal water system through your primary water meter that is used outside, so does not go into the municipal wastewater treatment system. Therefore, the Village does not have the expense of treating this water at the wastewater treatment plant. This is particularly prevalent for homeowners with irrigation systems, those who choose to utilize sprinklers, residents who have inground or large above ground pools, or those who simply enjoy other outdoor water activities. A second water meter, sometimes referred to as a deduct meter, may be installed to meter water used from your outdoor faucets.

Will installing a deduct meter be cost-effective for you? It's important to keep a few things in mind when determining if this is right for you:

Costs:

- Hardware must be purchased from the Village to be compatible with remote meter reading technology: Meter, MXU (remote reader) and Dual Meter Setter
- Plumbing Permit fee
- Licensed Plumber Installation Fee
- Public Works Inspection Fee

Your Water Demands:

- Pool filling
- Irrigation for landscaping
- Car Washing
- Gardening
- Kids Playing in the Sprinkler

Location and Space for Meter:

- Indoor Meter/Do you have the space?
- Outdoor MXU/Connected through an opening in the wall
