They noticed the Hampshire Chamber did not apply for one, Village President mentioned the Chamber hired a new woman so we'll give them time, their fee for a license is \$50.

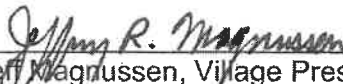

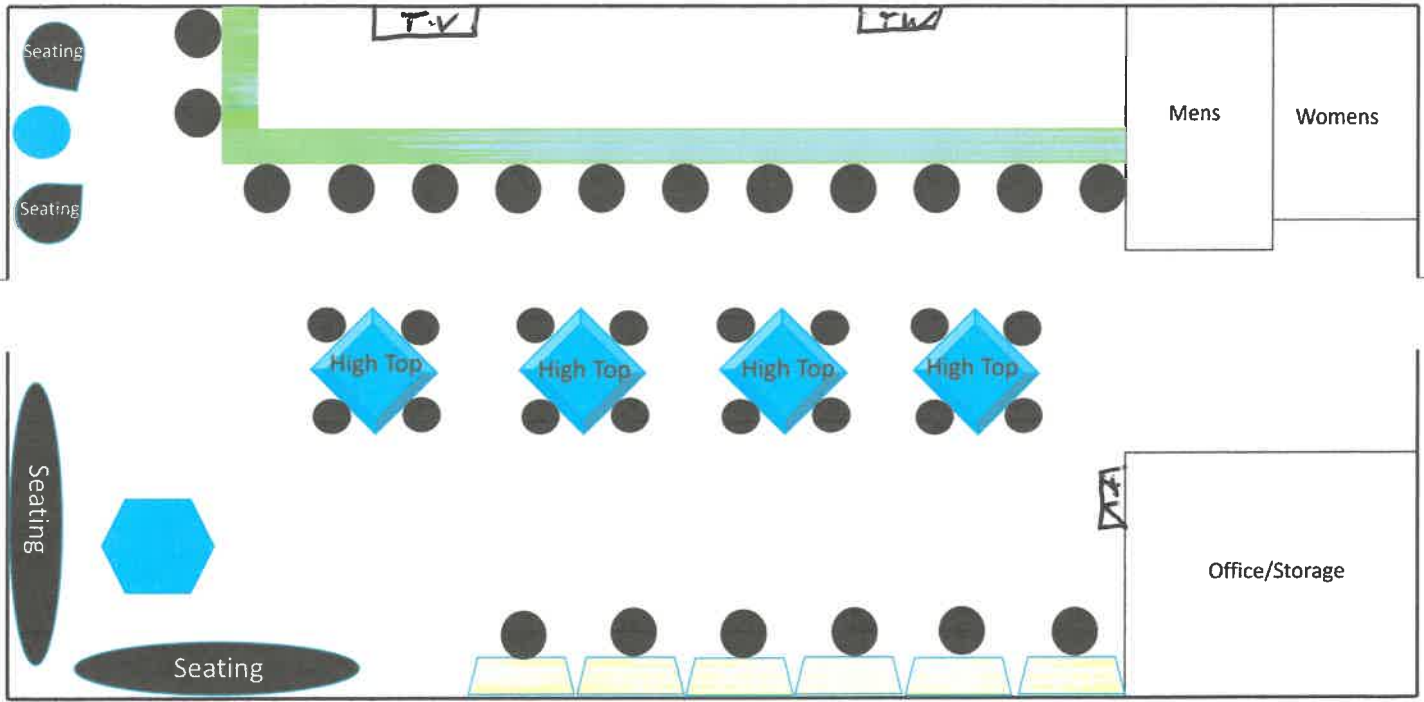

Hey Jim,

So I am going to draft this email for you to send to Jay and you can edit whatever you would like to make it your own. Copy and paste it where you see fit. I made the edits to the layout and again, only suggestions, take them or leave them, let me know what you think...

Good afternoon Jay,

Thank you for sending me this. Hopefully this can provide some clarity as to what I had envisioned that space to be. As per your questions:

I plan on having a staff of 5 employees, in addition to myself. All of which will be BASSET certified and will be capable of working both behind the bar as well as cocktail/serving. Being that Hampshire does not require a kitchen, we do not plan on having one. We do plan on offering "easy to make" snack options. Some examples may include things such as pizzas, ready-made sandwiches, or packaged charcuterie (cheese and cracker tray). Possibly having a popcorn machine might be something I would like to explore as well. Without having to have a kitchen, I will only need appropriate storage to maintain. No matter what food options I do decide on, myself and staff will have to be, and will get, appropriately certified to maintain the necessary Kane County Health Department standards.

All of that said, I feel that this will allow for me to staff essentially 1 person on during the day and 1 on during the evenings, with an overlap period. It may be necessary to

have a mid-day shift as well, so I may incorporate that as well, pending on how things go.

As far as hours of operation are concerned, I plan on operating in line with hours stated in the Hampshire municipal code. From my understanding it would be as follows:

**Class A-2 License - Taverns/No Carryout Sales:**

- 1 Licenses for the sale at retail of alcoholic liquors, over the counter for consumption on the premises. (Ord. 97-30, 9-18-1997)
- Establishments or premises holding a class A-2 liquor license shall close each night at one o'clock (1:00) A.M., and shall be closed as follows:

1:00 A.M. through 6:00 A.M. Sunday through Saturday of each week

To start, I am going to do 7am to 12am. I am sure it likely will not make sense to stay open until 12am every day of the week, but I would like to begin this way and see how it trends.

I plan on having a full functioning wet bar, complete with beer, wine, liquor, and soft drinks. I do not plan on a huge verity, but all means necessary for majority of spirit/cocktail possibilities. This list is not the final list by any means but more so what I will be choosing from . So you have an idea:

I'm not sure I follow this question. The very rough plan and layout provided, are what we plan on doing with the current space, which does not look like that being that it used to be an old Verison store. The plan here will be themed in sports bar fashion to teams of my liking and background. There will be a big TV behind the bar, possibly only one large one, or a large one with smaller ones surrounding it, to maximize game viewership. I am exploring the possibility of having one large TV opposite the bar wall TV, dedicated to having scrolling game lines/odds, if possible. I thought that would be a

fun and different idea that I haven't seen anywhere else and would push the sports bar look as well. Aside from that, the plan shows for having TVs in each of the corners, allowing for multiple game viewership.

We do plan on running daily drink specials, happy hour specials, and Vet and senior citizen discounts. All TBD at this moment, but we do want to market this place well. Along with those types of specials, again TBD, we would have a large marketing presence from the Gaming side as well, to promote play and push specials where legal and without conflict.

I hope this answers the questions you had. I understand that I have painted with a broad stroke for some of this, but that is only because I am not set in stone in the actual product yet. There is a lot to consider with potential vendors and what they can offer. I am looking to make this a successful profitable venture of course, but I do want to make it something that Hampshire can be proud to call one of their businesses in their community. Please don't hesitate if there is more you are looking for. I am eager and ready to move forward as soon as possible and as soon as you see this to be fitting.
